



Cobb Gate

There is perhaps no better symbol of the University of Chicago than Cobb Gate. Lined with expressive grotesques and draped in colorful ivy, Cobb Gate has stood as the entrance to the Main Quad for over 100 years. Passing underneath its exalted arch, one becomes a participant in a rich educational dialogue as well as a member of the greater historical University community.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Cut out the entire image along outside edges — including flaps.
- ✂ Make cuts first. Use an X-Acto knife for precision.
- Fold paper on white dashed lines.
- 📏 Use a table with a 90 degree angle or ruler for more precise folds.
- Bring together. Use glue or tape to adhere the flaps to rear side of image for a nice, sturdy structure.
- 📏 Line up the edges before adhering.
- ✂ Adhere tabs to the inside of the model using small pieces of tape or glue. Follow the numbered sequence.
