Steps away from the Regenstein Library, Hutchinson Commons, Bartlett Dining Hall, the Main Quadrangle.


Located on the Main Quad.

Suites consist of two bedrooms and two half bathrooms. One bathroom has a toilet and the other has a shower.


Home to 712 undergraduate students
